3. **Parking tags must be displayed on the rearview mirror and visible.** Failure to do so will result in a ticket.

4. Failure to follow the 'Parking and Traffic Regulations' section of the SHS Student Handbook.
5. Being tardy six (6) or more times per year.
6. Being placed on a required physician's note for poor attendance.
7. Leaving school without permission.
8. Reckless driving to or from school.
