| Grade 1 | 1 flat zipped pencil pouch 1 plastic square pencil box (for crayons, scissors, glue, etc.) 1 pair of school scissors 2 black dry erase markers – only black please 2 large glue sticks 1 highlighter 4 sharpened pencils (no mechanical pencils and/or pens) Box of 24 crayons (no markers) Ear buds (used during technology time) Old shirt for Art class |
| Grade 2 | Small pencil box Eraser (not shaped like a toy) Dry erase marker Highlighter Extra No. 2 pencils (NOT mechanical) |
| Grade 3 | Backpack 1-inch binder with front and back pocket Clean sock to erase white boards Black dry erase marker |
| Grade 4 | No. 2 pencils (NOT mechanical) 1-inch heavy-duty metal ring binder (NO Trapper Keepers or binders with plastic rings) One pack of tabbed subject dividers 3-hole punched sturdy folder that will fit in the binder Blunt-tipped school scissors 2 or 3 red and blue pens One highlighter Post-It Notes (any size) 2 or 3 dry erase markers Old, clean sock to erase white boards |
| Grade 5 | 1 three-inch binder 1 pack of notebook paper No. 2 pencils (NOT mechanical) Dividers for subject areas of binders – do not label Highlighters Blue pens Scissors (blunt tipped) Dry-erase markers Glue stick Book Covers Clean sock or white board eraser |
| Grade 6 | One 2-inch heavy-duty math binder (no zipper closure; no accordion-style, not larger than 2 inches) One 3-hole punched graph paper spiral notebook One pack of dividers One inexpensive pair of earbuds labeled with your child's name Zippered pencil pouch (not pencil box) with: pencils, highlighter, red pen and scissors |
