### Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course

- Prepares students to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician exam
- Course taught by SHS teacher
- In conjunction with HACC Public Safety, the course is based on the National EMS Education Standards.
- This 220-hour program serves as the foundation for emergency medical services, teaching students the overall roles and responsibilities of an EMT. The program prepares students to:
  - Rapidly assess injuries and illnesses
  - Administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
  - Provide care of musculoskeletal injuries
  - Use an AED to perform automated external defibrillation

### Internships



- An opportunity to help students understand and appreciate their academic coursework through direct application in the work setting
- Helps students gain work experience within our community and make informed decisions regarding their future career choice in a specialized program to meet their individual needs
- Internship expectations:
  - Student application & contract talk to counselor at scheduling meeting
  - Student interview with prospective host
  - Host Supervisor professional industry expert with completed clearances to mentor student and connect them to hands-on, real-world learning
  - Teacher Mentor in relevant curricular area to support student internship through meaningful opportunities and reflection
  - Required student assignments (weekly journal entries, midterm and final evaluations, capstone presentation)

### Who should consider an Internship?

- Have an idea of a career or pathway that they are interested in pursuing and have or are taking coursework relevant to that pathway (for connections/extension).
- Are in good standing towards graduation as they will need to make space in their schedule to spend a portion of their school day at their internship site.
- Have strong interpersonal skills as they will not only be serving as a reputation of themself, but of Southern York County School District.
- Have the ability to provide their own transportation to access off campus internship sites.

### **YCAL Career Exploration Programs**



Programs that offer students information about a specific career field

- Open to high school students in grades 10-12 (with priority given to 11th and 12th grade students)
- In-person sessions in both the fall and spring semesters
  - Fall 2021 had 7 career fields
  - Spring 2022 has 14 career fields
- Virtual library of career exploration programs from 2020-2021 school year
- Juniors can use this as a graduation project field experience
