How Do I Apply for One of these Scholarships?

An application for the SYCSD Foundation scholarships is located at https://sycsdf.dollarsforscholars.org/. Click the "Students and Parents" tab on the right side of the page. Then click the "Click to Login" button. If this is your first time signing into Dollars for Scholars ChapterNet, click the "Click Here" link in the top center of the page. Otherwise use your existing account information to sign in. Once you sign in and complete the application you will be matched to Foundation scholarships for which you qualify. It is important to answer all requested information completely and thoroughly. Some scholarships will require parents and references to sign into the system to complete required sections.
