## Test Facts

- Administered by The College Board based in Princeton, NJ
- A Reasoning-Based Test
- Assesses how students perform on tasks or items they may not have had prior knowledge or training with.
- Contains an evidenced-based reading & writing section and a math section.
- Traditionally, the SHS School Counseling Department recommended students take the exam in the spring of their Junior year and again in the Fall of their Senior year.
- Accepted by all 3,500 post-secondary institutions.
- *Extended testing time and/or other accommodations may be available. However, you have to apply eight (8) weeks in advance of your first testing date. See your school counselor for more information.*

## Structure

- The SAT is a total of 3 hours
- There are 2 Tests: Evidence-Based Reading/Writing Test & Math
  - The Reading section is 65 minutes in length and contains 52 items (5 passages).
  - The Writing & Language section is 35 minutes in length and contains 44 items (4 passages).
  - The Math section is 80 minutes in length & includes 58 items.
    - 25 minutes of this section is without a calculator.

- **Math:** Scale from 200 – 800
- **Reading & Writing/Language:** Scale from 200 - 800
- **Highest Possible Score of a 1600**



## Test Facts

- Administered by The ACT based in Iowa City, IA
- A Curriculum-Based Achievement Test
- Assesses students' understanding of core subject (except Social Studies) content as aligned with state standards in 27 states.
- Contains a science, a math, a reading, and a writing section.
- Traditionally, the SHS School Counseling Department recommended students take the exam in the spring of their Junior year and again in the Fall of their Senior year.
- Accepted by all 3,500 post-secondary institutions.
- *Extended testing time and/or other accommodations may be available. Please select requested accommodations for the test date you are registering for.*

## Structure

- The ACT is a total of 3 hours and 25 minutes (3 Hours and 55 minutes with an optional essay)
- There are 4 Tests: Reading, English, Science, and Math
  - The Reading section is 35 minutes in length and contains 40 items.
  - The English section is 45 minutes in length and contains 75 items.
  - The Math section is 60 minutes in length and includes 60 items.
  - The Science section is 35 minutes in length and includes 40 items.
  - There is an optional 40-minute writing prompt section; It is taken at the end of the test.

## Scoring

- **Math:** Scale from 1-36
- **English:** Scale from 1-36
- **Reading:** Scale from 1-36
- **Science:** Scale from 1-36
- **Composite:** Scale from 1-36  
*The Composite Score is an average of the 4 above sections. It does not include Writing.*
- **Writing:** Subscore, Scale 2-12.
- **Highest Possible Score of a 36**
