Create a 3-5 minute presentation about your plan after high school. Use the following outline as a guide to help you create your presentation

Criteria	My Plans / Facts
Introduction	
Grabs Audience Attention <i>Grab the attention of the audience by creating a strong introduction. (statistics, questioning techniques, videos, music, and/or images)</i>	
Reason for Career Choice	
Justification of Exploration <i>Identify your career choice and explain why you have selected this.</i>	
Facts About Career	
Nature of Work <i>Identify the job description and day-to-day tasks performed.</i>	
Training / Qualifications / Education <i>Identify training, education, or qualifications needed to enter this career path. You may want to include necessary skills and/or abilities needed.</i>	
Job Outlook / Employment Statistics <i>Identifies current employment outlook for the position either for the state or nationally.</i>	
Salary / Earnings <i>Identifies potential earnings in this career path.</i>	
Field Experience	
Reason for Choice <i>Identifies the field experiences you completed and why you chose to participate.</i>	

<p>Knowledge Gained <i>The student identifies what he/she learned from their experience.</i></p>	
<p>Benefits of Experience <i>Outline what benefit participating in the field experiences had on you. Some questions to consider: Did it help you confirm or rule out a pathway?</i></p>	
<p>Career Plan</p>	
<p>High School Planning <i>Identify what you have done throughout high school to get you prepared for this pathway.</i></p>	
<p>Post-Secondary Education Plan <i>Identifies what your education plan is after high school to gain the skill necessary for their career choice (on-the-job-training, military, technical school, college, etc)</i></p>	
<p>Identify Next Steps to Take <i>Identifies the next steps necessary after high school to reach your career goal</i></p>	
<p>Use of Media</p>	
<p>Creativity <i>Use a media form to present your information along with your speech.</i></p>	
<p>Attractive <i>Design a visual aid that is visually appealing to the audience.</i></p>	
<p>Value Added – Enhances Presentation <i>Make sure your visual aid adds value and supplemented the presentation. Do not simply read off PowerPoint Slides</i></p>	
<p>Quality of Presentation</p>	
<p>Professionalism <i>Make sure you act professionally using professional language (both written and oral). Free from spelling and/or grammar errors.</i></p>	
<p>Well Rehearsed <i>Complete this project outline and rehearse your presentation</i></p>
